Tracking Technologies/Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We use cookies on this site. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time. We use cookies for personalization and tracking. - Analytics / Log Files

As is true of most web sites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes Internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data.

- 3rd Party Tracking

The use of cookies by our partners, affiliates, tracking utility company, service providers is not covered by our privacy statement. We do not have access or control over these cookies. Our partners, affiliates, tracking utility company, service providers use session ID cookies to make it easier for you to navigate our site. Our third party partners employ clear gifs (a.k.a. Web Beacons/Web Bugs), images, and scripts that help them better manage content on our site. We do not tie the information gathered to personally identifiable information.

Security
